She told us that we should renew our visa now. So, we got all the paperwork ready and gave it to her. We went to immigration and we were shocked. We had an appointment at 10:30 and we were on our way home at 10:40. What an amazing thing God did! Normally you must wait and wait. Glory to His Holy Name! Visas are a big concern for missionaries and God did an amazing work! Thank you for praying for us!



News from a foreign land: This month we would like you to meet a friend of ours. His name is Duh. He started coming to church when we first started. Many times, he would come off and on. Duh was just a little guy. He would sit in the chair and his feet would barely touch the floor. He had lots of problems in his life. He was an alcoholic and used drugs. Many times, he would pass out in the road. He lived in a lean-to. The lean-to was four polls holding up the roof and a piece of plywood on the ground with a mattress on it to sleep on. He had an adopted family, but they disowned him because of his sins. But God helped us to love this little guy. He had problems, but he had a good heart and would do anything he could for you. When he came to church, sometimes he was not the cleanest or would sleep. We would tell people that he was okay and that he was our friend. One Sunday he came to church and sat in the back.
